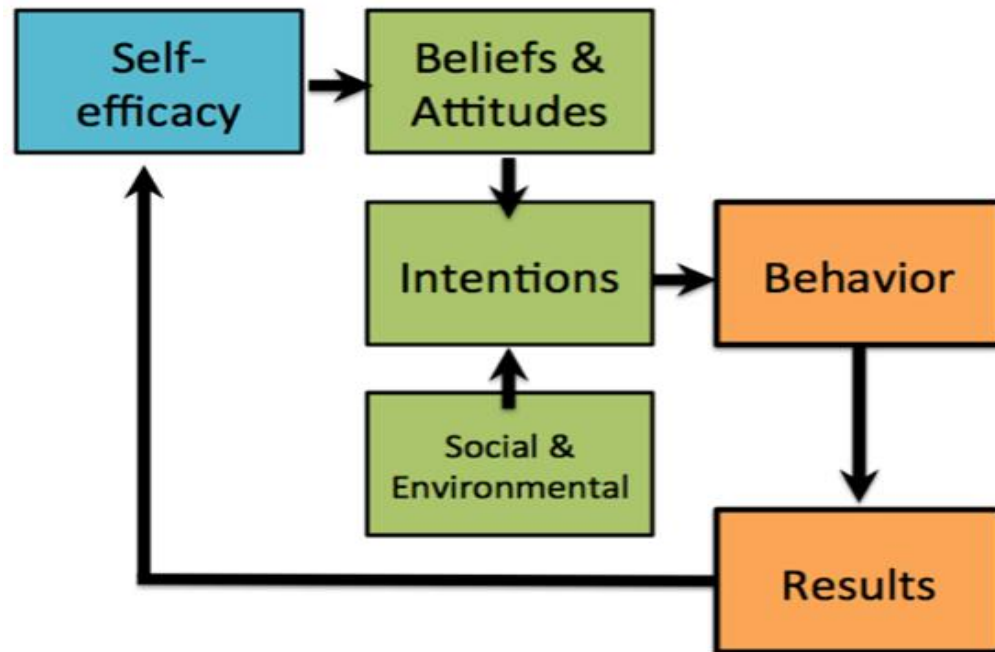

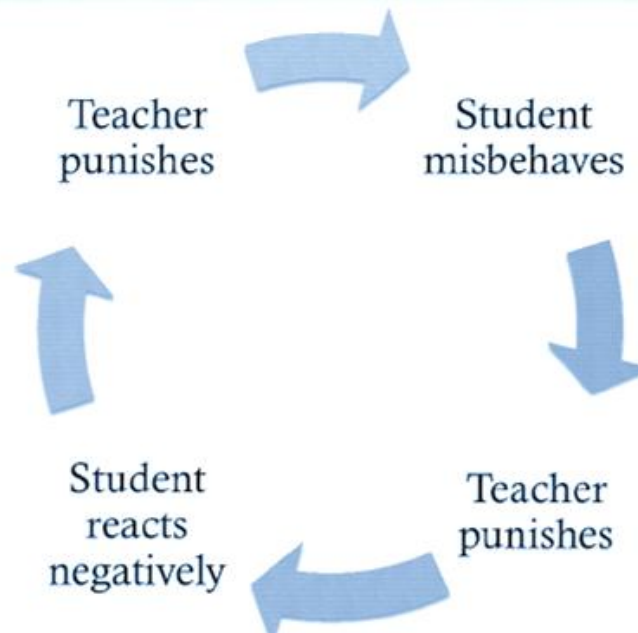

Classroom Design

Make Your Class Work For You

- Lighting, color, music, smell
- Where have I placed my desks or tables?
- Where do I stand to deliver my teacher-directed information?
- Where are the windows?
- Where are my 'membership loops'?
- What are the existing traffic patterns?



Teach To Expectations

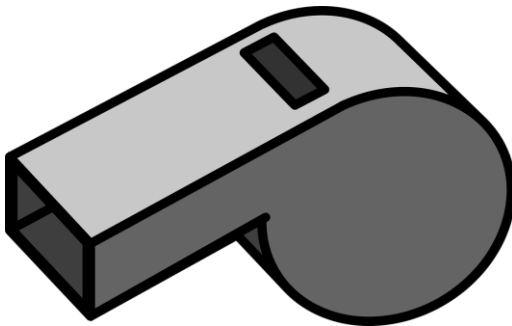

Focus On The Behavior



Ask Yourself:

The Virtual Counseling Program provide social skills education and counseling resources so small schools can meet their state requirements and give their students the additional support they need to really succeed.

LEVEL 1

SchoolToolsTv Daily 1 Minute Social Skills Videos

- New videos each day for K-2, 3-7 & 8-12.
- Provides Tier 1 RTI/PBIS Instruction & Support.
- Helps increase teachable time, reduce behavior problems & improves academic results.
- Creates conversations about rules & expectations.
- Provides great questions for writing prompts.

Cost - \$75 per teacher.

LEVEL 2

SchoolToolsTv Daily Videos & Monthly 30 Minute Skype Visits with Counselor

- Subscription to SchoolToolsTv.
- Monthly social skills group meeting with a counselor - Tier 2 RTI/PBIS support.
- Regular email contact with each teacher to identify problem areas.
- Tailor meetings to the specific needs of each class or student.

Cost - \$500 for each class.

LEVEL 3

SchoolToolsTv Daily Videos & Weekly or Biweekly 30 Minute Skype Visits with Counselor

- Subscription to SchoolToolsTv
- Weekly or Biweekly group meetings providing additional Tier 2 RTI/PBIS support.
- Regular email contact with each teacher to identify problem areas.
- Tailor meetings to the specific needs of each class or student.

Cost - \$1,000 - \$2,000 for each class
