Virtual Professional Development: New MT Science Assessment

Virtual Workshop Description

This coming spring (2021), the state of Montana plans to implement the Montana Science Assessment (MSA) and the Alt MSA that aligns with the current science standards that were implemented in July of 2017 for the first time. Due to the pandemic the field test planned for the spring of 2020 received a federal waiver. This is the first time that the science assessments will be in an online format. Also, the grades that students are tested in science have changed. Students will now be tested in 5th and 8th grades, and the ACT test will act as the science test for 11th grade. Science has also been added to the ESSA plan as an accountability component, which it has not been in the past.

The assessment will be measuring the three dimensions of the science standards, the Science and Engineering Practices, the Disciplinary Core Ideas, and the Crosscutting Concepts. To familiarize yourself and be prepared for this assessment, we will spend the day reviewing the sample test items, and addressing these components that the students will need to know and be able to do.
